I would like to submit this letter regarding my Army IPEB Rating Decision, dated May 12, 2009.

I feel that the assigned rating for my Asthma condition is incorrect. I was given a 10% rating because my FEV-1 test result was 75%. The IPEB was not able to take into account, however, that I require the use of an inhaler every day. This is rated by the VASRD as 30%. The medical record that notes my inhaler usage could not be located when the IPEB first reviewed my case. I have since been able to locate it, and have attached it to this letter, with highlights noting the daily use of an inhaler.

I would greatly appreciate a full review of this condition and all my other conditions to ensure that my ratings are correct. Thank you for your time and consideration.
